In Strokestown Park House, Gardens & National Famine Museum we discover the intimate and intriguing links between dramatically different Irish lives and explore the parallel lives of Strokestown Park's aristocratic landlords and their tenants during the Great Irish Famine at the state-

of-the-art National Famine Museum. On the way home we stop at the Corlea Iron Age Roadway; Hidden away in the boglands, an inspiring relic of prehistory: a *togher* – an Iron Age road – built in 148 BC. Known locally as the Danes' Road,

it is the largest of its kind to have been uncovered in Europe.

take us to Lough Ree and the hotel.
