Proposed Itinerary

Day 1Wednesday, 19th June, 2019

Activity As tour members arrive independently at Glasgow Airport, cross the road to the Holiday Inn, and check in under MINCH MUSIC TOUR. (Note: The Holiday Inn, and NOT the Holiday Inn Express) Gather in the bar for a Welcome Drink at 6.00pm, prior to Dinner at 7.00pm.
 Evening Hotel Holiday Inn, Glasgow Airport. (D. B.)

Day 2 Thursday, 20th June, 2019

Activity Depart hotel at 9.00am, and drive north on the A82 Loch Lomond road, with stops at the <u>Green Welly</u> in Tyndrum, and the <u>Glencoe Visitor Centre</u>. Drive to <u>Banavie</u>, just past <u>Fort William</u> for checking into the Moorings Hotel. Our hotel is beside <u>Neptune's Staircase</u>, a series of eight locks at the south end of the Caledonian Canal, built by Thomas Telford between 1803 and 1822. (Independent Lunch, in Tyndrum, or at the Glencoe Visitor Centre)

Day 3 Friday, 21st June, 2019

Activity Easy scenic drive following <u>Glen Nevis</u>, a favourite area for movie locations. The glen is also the approach for <u>Ben Nevis</u>, the highest point in the UK at 4,411 ft. The afternoon is free! Options include: shopping; walking in Glen Nevis; <u>Ben Nevis Distillery</u>; <u>Old Inverlochy Castle</u>; the <u>Highland Museum</u>. Lots to do! (Independent Lunch wherever you are) Bus drop-off/pick-up in Fort William.

Day 4 Saturday, 22nd June, 2019

Activity We drive north to Fort Augustus where the Caledonian Canal enters Loch Ness by way of a multiple of locks. During our time at the southern end of Loch Ness we can further experience the loch by taking a 50 min cruise on the water. Fort Augustus is a picturesque village of 600 that gets packed with visitors during the summer months. Originally an 18th-century garrison, Fort August lies at the junction of four old military roads and is cut in two by the Caledonian Canal. We can find out more information at the Caledonian Canal Heritage Centre. Also of interest is the Clansman Centre, which provides insight into 17th-century Highland life. (Independent Lunch in Fort Augustus)

Day 5 Sunday, 23rd June, 2019

A leisurely drive west to the Glenfinnan Monument & Visitor Centre.	
In 1815, the 18m-high monument was built here, with the lone, kilted highlander	
at the top providing a poignant reminder of the clansmen who gave their lives to	
the Jacobite cause. The modern exhibition in the visitor centre tells the story of	
Prince Charles Edward Stuart and the 1745 Jacobite Rising.

Day 6 Monday, 24th June, 2019

 Activity Departing the Moorings Hotel, we head for <u>Craignure</u> on the <u>Isle of Mull</u>. Driving back south to <u>Ballachulish</u>, we take the coastal route to Oban, round by Appin. Our main stop is the <u>Sea Life Sanctuary</u> at Barcaldine. Later, the 4.00pm ferry from Oban to Craignure brings us to the Isle of Mull Hotel in good time for a 5.00pm check in. (Independent Lunch in Barcaldine)

Day 7 Tuesday, 25th June, 2019

Activity Iona Day! Today we drive to Fionnphort, where we board the passenger ferry for a short 15 min. journey to Iona, sometimes known as the Holy Isle. Upon arrival we have arranged a Nature Ramble with local Rangers/Guides, and after lunch we break into two groups for a guided tour in Iona Abbey. (Independent Lunch on Iona)

Day 9 Thursday, 27th June, 2019

Activity Our first stop is **Duart Castle**, the ancestral home of the Macleans of Duart. The current Clan Chief, Sir Lachlan, is often in residence. Built in 1360, by Chief Lachlan Lubanach Maclean, the position of Duart was well chosen. It is sited on a high crag at the end of a peninsula jutting into the Sound of Mull. It commands the channel between Mull and the mainland, the entrances to Loch Linnhe and Loch Etive, and the neck of the Firth of Lorne as it meets the Sound of Mull. We can enjoy a 10.30am guided tour of the castle. There is a café on site which is famous for home baked cakes! (The photo on page 1 of this itinerary is of Duart Castle, and the Sound of Mull) In the afternoon we drive to **Tobermory**, the largest town, where you will have the option of a tour of the **Tobermory Distillery**. You may also want to see 'The Western Isles Hotel' which was in the 1945 movie 'I Know Where I'm Going' (Independent Lunch at Duart, or in Tobermory) After Dinner, Entertainment with Men of Worth Evening Isle of Mull Hotel, Craignure, Argyll-shire (D. Day 10 Friday, 28th June, 2019

Activity We depart Craignure on the 9.55am ferry to Oban, and continue to <u>Inveraray</u> for our main stop. Later, the <u>Loch Fyne Oyster Bar</u> is a must-do as we wend our way back to Glasgow Airport, and the Holiday Inn. (Independent Lunch in Inveraray)
