Proposed Itinerary

Day 1 Wednesday, 9th June, 2021

Activity As tour members arrive independently at Glasgow Airport, cross the road to the

Holiday Inn, and check in under **MINCH MUSIC TOUR**. (Note: The Holiday Inn, and NOT the Holiday Inn Express)

Gather in the bar for a Welcome Drink at 6.00pm, prior to Dinner at 7.00pm.

Evening After **Dinner**, Evening free to relax and prepare for morning departure.

Hotel Holiday Inn, Glasgow Airport. (D. B.)

Day 2 Thursday, 10th June, 2021

Activity Depart hotel at 9.00am, and drive north on the A82 Loch Lomond road, with

stops at the Green Welly in Tyndrum, and the Glencoe Visitor Centre. Drive to

Banavie, just past Fort William for checking into the Moorings Hotel.

Our hotel is beside Neptune's Staircase, a series of eight locks at the south end of the Caledonian Canal, built by Thomas Telford between 1803 and 1822. (Independent Lunch, at the Green Welly, or at the Glencoe Visitor Centre)

Day 3 Friday, 11th June, 2021

Activity We drive north to **Fort Augustus** where the Caledonian Canal enters Loch Ness

by way of a flight of locks. Fort Augustus, cut in two by the canal, is originally an 18th-century garrison, and lies at the junction of four old military roads. We can find out more information at the **Caledonian Canal Heritage Centre**. Also, the **Clansman Centre** provides insight into 17th-century Highland life. Following an independent lunch, we are planning to charter a **Cruise Boat** for an

hour and a half on the Loch in the afternoon. (Independent Lunch in Fort Augustus)

Day 4 Saturday, 12th June, 2021

Activity Easy morning drive from our hotel tracking the canal north to the **Commando**

Memorial by Spean Bridge. The monument overlooks the Lochaber region and stands as a memorial to the British Commandos who trained in the area. In the Garden of Remembrance many families have erected tributes to loved ones of contemporary Commando units who have lost their lives in more recent conflicts

such as the Falklands War or in Afghanistan and Iraq.

We return to Fort William on the main A82 road for an afternoon of Free Time. Options include: shopping; walking in Glen Nevis; **Ben Nevis Distillery**; **Old**

Inverlochy Castle; the **Highland Museum**. Lots to do!

(Independent Lunch wherever you are) Bus drop-off/pick-up in Fort William.

Evening After **Dinner**. Entertainment with **Men of Worth**.

Day 5 Sunday, 13th June, 2021

Activity A leisurely drive west to the **Glenfinnan Monument & Visitor Centre**.

The 18m-high monument was built here in 1815. The exhibition in the Visitor Centre tells the history of **Prince Charles Edward Stuart** and the subsequent

1745 Jacobite Rising.

The nearby **Glenfinnan Viaduct**, of Harry Potter fame, is a good photo

opportunity as the steam train passes.

Day 6 Monday, 14th June, 2021

Activity Departing the Moorings Hotel, we head for **Craignure** on the **Isle of Mull**.

Driving back south to <u>Ballachulish</u>, we take the coastal route round by Appin to <u>Oban</u>. We have 4 hours of free time in Oban. Later, the 3.55pm ferry from **Oban to Craignure** brings us to the **Isle of Mull Hotel** in good time for a 5.00pm

check in.

Day 7 Tuesday, 15th June, 2021

Activity Iona Day! Today we drive to **Fionnphort**, where we board the passenger

ferry to **Iona**, sometimes known as the **Holy Isle**. Upon arrival we have arranged a **Nature Ramble** with local **Rangers/Guides**, and after lunch we break into two

groups for a guided tour in **Iona Abbey**.

Day 8 Wednesday, 16th June, 2021

Activity A leisurely day during which we visit **Duart Castle**, the ancestral home of the

Maclean's of Duart. The current Clan Chief, Sir Lachlan, is often in residence. Built in 1360, by Chief Lachlan Lubanach Maclean, the position of Duart was well chosen. It is sited on a high crag at the end of a peninsula jutting into the Sound of Mull. It commands the channel between Mull and the mainland, the entrances to Loch Linnhe and Loch Etive, and the neck of the Firth of Lorne as it meets the

Sound of Mull.

We will schedule a guided tour of the castle. There is an excellent café on site

which is famous for home baked cakes!

way back to Glasgow Airport, and the Holiday Inn.
